Call to Worship

We **are** called into worship by God Himself. He sets the terms for worship because He makes worship possible through Jesus Christ.

Invocation

This prayer addresses God in three persons, asking Him to be present with us in worship to help us worship Him according to His will.

Call to Confession

As we see God in His invitation and our praise, we cannot help but see how we have fallen short **of His glory**. God's Holy Scripture has the authority to reveal us to ourselves and transition our hearts to confession. LEADER: You hypocrite, first take the log out of your own eye, and then you will see clearly to take the speck out of your brother's eye.

PEOPLE: So whatever you wish that others would do to you, do also to them, for this is the Law and the Prophets."

Whether seated or kneeling, let us approach the Lord together with a posture of reverence.


